

MV Moana Chief – CV1700 Container Vessel

The China Navigation Company (CNCo), the deep sea ship owning and operating arm of the multi-national Swire Group, are proud to introduce the MV Moana Chief. Operated by Pacifica Shipping, it is the largest dedicated domestic container vessel to operate on the New Zealand coast. Operating to a schedule of two 'fixed day' weekly rotations, services connect domestic shippers together with importers and exporters seeking to connect with international voyages.

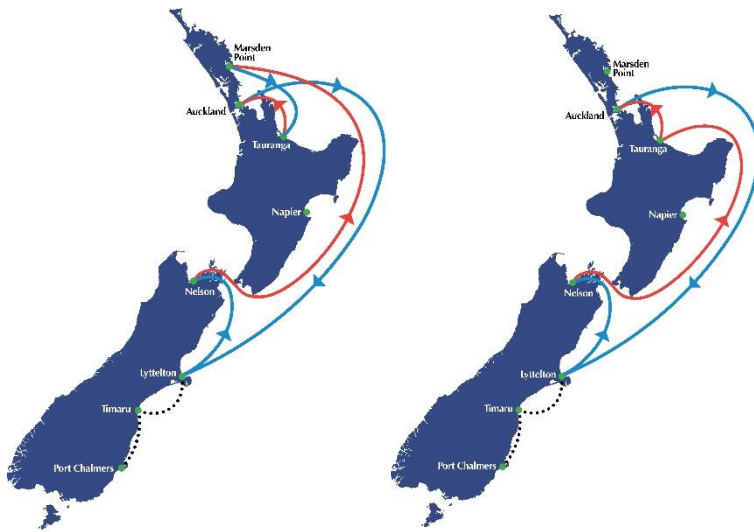


Pacifica's dedicated primary service rotations are;
