



COVID Alert Level 4 - Pacifica update

Dear Customer,

As announced by the Government yesterday evening, New Zealand will move to COVID Alert Level 4 for three days effective from 11.59pm Tuesday 17 August.

Auckland and the Coromandel Peninsula will remain in Alert Level 4 for seven days through to midnight Tuesday 24 August.

As an essential service provider, Pacifica Shipping will continue to operate our dedicated coastal service, subject to the restrictions and guidelines applicable to this alert level.

We have reinstated working protocols and measures to keep our staff and customers safe whilst maintaining our normal services just as we have done in previous lock-downs.

Our vessel the *MV Moana Chief* remains on schedule to arrive Auckland tomorrow (Thursday 19th) and is expected to complete cargo operations and depart as planned for eta Lyttleton Saturday 21st August.
